




Absentee Ballot Status Check



If you requested an absentee ballot for this election, please check your absentee ballot status before attempting to vote in-person. Please follow the steps below to check your absentee ballot status.



STEP 1: Access MVP (My Voter Page) In your internet browser, enter **mvp.sos.ga.gov**. Once you have accessed the My Voter Page, enter your first initial, last name, date of birth, and the county in which you are registered to vote.

STEP 2: Select the **Absentee Ballot Status** Link

STEP 3: Review your absentee ballot information



If your absentee ballot status shows **ACCEPTED**, your ballot has been received by the County Registrar’s office. You have already voted in the election. You may exit the line.

If your absentee ballot status is blank, your absentee ballot hasn’t been received by the County Registrar’s office. You may cancel your absentee ballot here at the polling location and vote using the voting equipment.



Check your absentee ballot status using the GA SOS App


STEP 1: Download the **GA SOS App** on your IOS or Android phone/tablet.




STEP 2: Select the **My Voter Information** tab. This will navigate you to the My Voter Page.




STEP 3: Enter your first initial, last name, date of birth, and the county in which you are registered to vote.



STEP 4: Once your voter information appears, select **Absentee Ballot** at the bottom of the screen.




STEP 5: Select the **Absentee Ballot Status** link.




STEP 6: Select the Election Date
