CANDIDATES APPEARING ON THE NONPARTISAN AND DEMOCRATIC PARTY BALLOT:

Nonpartisan candidates **and** candidates seeking the Democratic nomination shall file a Notice of Candidacy and Affidavit or Declaration of Candidacy in the office of the Election Superintendent at **Ware Co Board of Elections and Registration, 408 Tebeau St**. **Nonpartisan candidates and Democratic candidates with additional questions can contact the Ware Co Elections Office at 912-287-4363.**

The May Primary/Nonpartisan Election will be held on May 21, 2024 and the General Election will be held on November 5, 2024.
