Voter Checklist

- 1. Confirm the status of your registration at least 4 weeks prior to the date of the election. Update your registration information, such as address and name. How? Contact the Ware County Board of Elections at 912-287-4363 or inquire at www.mvp.sos.ga.gov
- 2. Know how and when to apply for an Absentee By-Mail Ballot if you are unable to vote in person at your polling place on Election Day or during the Advance In-Person Voting period.
- 3. Know the voter identification requirements before you attempt to vote.
- 4. Know your polling place location and how to get there.
- 5. Familiarize yourself with the voting device used. Learn how the device is accessible to voters with disabilities.
- 6. Learn who can assist in voting and who can receive assistance
- 7. Know what time the polls open and close (7am until 7pm)
- 8. Obtain a Sample Ballot from the Elections Office to become acquainted with candidates and other items on the ballot. Access a sample ballot HERE
- 9. Consider becoming a poll worker: We are looking for dedicated citizens who would like to assist us in the election process. We need dedicated individuals who take pride in their work, detail-oriented and willing to take direction; those who are patient and enjoy working with people. If this is you, please consider becoming a Ware County Poll Worker.
